## MOLECULAR PATHOLOGY ON COLON CANCER

**April**, 16 – 17, 2009 (I: Theoretical Part)

Short description: This theoretical-practical course is designed for pathologists, molecular biologists and technicians with special interest in diagnostic molecular pathology of colon cancer. Topics include DNA / RNA extraction from formalin-fixed paraffin embedded tissue, immunohistochemical analysis of DNA repair enzymes), microsatellite instability (MSI), mutation analysis of B-RAF, methylation analysis and detection of KRAS mutations. During this intensive course, the participants will gain extensive knowledge and hands-on experience in the lab course. Major pitfalls will be discussed.
